COMMON TERMS IN THIS VIDEO



STRING NAMES 6 STRING GUITAR

- E A D G B E - thickest to thinnest.



STRING NAMES 4 STRING BASS GUITAR

- E A D G - thickest to thinnest.



SOUND HOLE

Attached to the guitar neck where the tuning pegs are located..



HEADSTOCK

Attached to the guitar neck where the tuning pegs are located.



BRIDGE PINS

On most acoustic guitars, there are pins on the bridge that hold the strings in place.

HINTS & SAFETY

» Remembering String Names!

» **Guitar**

E emus

A and

D dingos

G go

B bush

E everyday

» **Bass**

E emus

A and

D dingos

G go

» Be careful not to overtune strings as they may break!

» Strings last longer if they are clean. Wipe them down with a clean cloth after playing.

» Check the internet for free guitar tuning apps you can download onto your phone. For example, the Boss TU-3 chromatic tuner is a good one.
